



SIPSAW – School Improvement Plan for Student Achievement and Wellness – Literacy

Cycle 2 Goal: 80% of our focus students will demonstrate an improvement in their ability to substantiate their arguments from an open-ended question shared in curriculum areas studied outside of the Literacy block

Plan:

- *We will use the Literacy curriculum to find connections to content area subjects such as Science and Social Studies*
- *By February our focus students will demonstrate an improvement in their ability to communicate important ideas shared in non-fiction texts*
- *We will create success criteria for active listening strategies that students can use when participating in shared reading activities in content area subjects*

Effective March 2019:

- *We will use strategies to help students effectively support their ideas and opinions*
- *We will intentionally use more open-ended guiding questions to help students view texts from different view points while additionally helping raise student engagement levels amongst themselves*
- *We will help students develop skills to have discussions with their peers about topics that generate different opinions*
